



Code of Conduct for Instructors

and other relevant Club Volunteers / Officers

- Never instruct above your level of training and expertise.
- Ensure you attend all relevant updating, access ongoing professional development training and maintain a current enhanced DBS check or if working in a non-regulated activity complete a Self-Disclosure form as required for your position.
- Never ridicule or shout at a young person for making a mistake - treat them with respect and you will receive respect.
- Be reasonable in your demands on the young person's activity according to their level of ability and expertise.
- Operate within the rules and safety codes of the BSAC.
- Ensure equipment provided is suitable for purpose and has been regularly checked to ensure it is safe to use.
- Display control and professionalism at all times to all parties including students, fellow instructors, parents and Club officers.
- Show concern towards sick or injured students and ensure proper medical treatment is obtained.
- Refer any concerns raised by the student to the relevant Club Officer and ensure action is taken.
- Make yourself fully aware of the BSAC Safeguarding Policy and actions to take if you have a concern or a concern is raised to you.
- All physical contact with the student should be appropriate to the requirements of the sport.
- Ensure you are fully aware of all BSAC guidelines on physical handling of students.
- Always respect the rights, dignity and worth of the student regardless of gender, ability, culture, background, religion, ethnic origin or sexual orientation.
